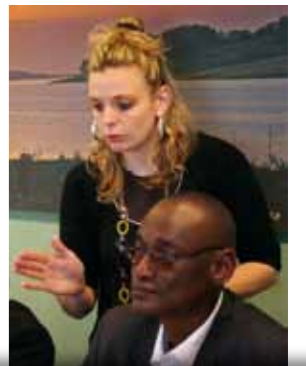
The CACG is involved in international networks (AFEID, CIID, CIGB) and creates partnerships to meet each project's requirements with:
